

SMILE Scholarships Test for Admission & Ranking - 2023 (SMILE STAR TEST- 2023)

INTRODUCTION – A test “SMILE Scholarships Test for Admission & Ranking – 2023” or SMILE STAR TEST -2023 has been started for admission, ranking & scholarship for the students who are seeking admission in SMILE School and for the students already studying in SMILE School as well. The Test is a compulsory test for all the two types of students.

OBJECTIVES OF TEST –

- To prepare a list of students class wise on the basis of their score in the test.
- To award them a rank on the basis of their score.
- The rank in the test will guide the school management to decide a suitable class in SMILE School or a suitable group/section in the class.
- Since the group will be made on the basis of score in the test, SMILE teachers shall be fully aware that what type of attentions and how much efforts are needed to a particular group of students for their development in a class.
- Scholarships will be provided to the top rankers of each class from I to XII. Rules and criteria for scholarship has been explained in detail in the following section.

ABOUT TEST –

- The test will be conducted from class I to class VIII.
- The test will be scheduled at the same time for all classes in the campus of SMILE School, Near Dhankund Police Station, Banka-813105.
- The question paper will be in both medium – English & Hindi.
- For each correct question four marks will be given, for each wrong answer one mark will be deducted and for no attempt of question no mark will be given.
- The total number of questions will be 80 for which the maximum marks in the test will be 320. These questions must be solved in a time duration of two and half hours.

- परीक्षा में शामिल होने के लिए दो तिथियां होंगी–
पहला - जनवरी पहला रविवार दूसरा - जनवरी दूसरा रविवार।
- दोनों परीक्षाओं के बाद परिणाम और रैंकिंग सामूहिक रूप से घोषित की जाएगी।
- स्टार्स परीक्षा शुल्क (स्कूल प्रॉस्पेक्टस के बिना) - ₹ 300 (रिफंडेबल नहीं)।
- पहली से पांचवीं कक्षा तक किसी भी कक्षा में छात्रवृत्ति के लिए अर्हता प्राप्त करने वाले केवल कक्षा पांच तक छात्रवृत्ति के लिए पात्र होंगे। छठी कक्षा से छात्रवृत्ति के लिए उसे स्टार्स टेस्ट में फिर से उपस्थित होना होगा।
- छठी से आठवीं कक्षा तक किसी भी कक्षा में पढ़ने वालों को दसवीं कक्षा तक के लिए छात्रवृत्ति प्रदान की जाएगी।
- केवल उन्हीं को गोल्ड छात्रवृत्ति के लिए शॉर्टलिस्ट किया जाएगा जो परीक्षा में 70 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करते हैं। रजत या कांस्य छात्रवृत्ति के लिए शॉर्टलिस्ट उन्हे किया जाएगा जो परीक्षा में 50 प्रतिशत अंक प्राप्त करते हैं।
- एडमिशन के लिए - स्टार्स टेस्ट में क्वालिफाइंग मार्क्स 40 फीसदी होंगे।
- छात्रावास की सुविधा केवल लड़कों के लिए उपलब्ध है।
- छात्राओं को सिल्वर और ब्रॉन्ज कैटेगरी में स्कॉलरशिप के लिए अतिरिक्त वेटेज दिया जाएगा। छात्रवृत्ति केवल उन्हीं छात्रों के लिए मान्य होगी जिनकी शेष फीस का भुगतान एक समय पर किया जाता है।
- छात्र ऑनलाइन या ऑफलाइन दोनों आवेदन कर सकते हैं।

एडमिशन

- लगभग एक सप्ताह के बाद, छात्र / माता-पिता को प्राप्त अंकों के साथ स्कोर / रैंक के साथ सूचित किया जाएगा.
- अभिभावकों को सलाह दी जाती है कि वे काउंसलिंग के लिए प्रिंसिपल/अधिकृत शिक्षक के समक्ष उपस्थित हों, जो परीक्षा के बाद निःशुल्क होगी। काउंसलिंग के बाद माता-पिता अपने बच्चों के लिए अच्छी तरह से निर्णय ले सकते हैं.
- यदि छात्र स्टार्स टेस्ट में कक्षा में प्रवेश के लिए अर्हता प्राप्त नहीं कर सके, तो काउंसलिंग सत्र में नीचे की कक्षा में एडमिशन पर विचार किया जाएगा ।

परीक्षा में प्राप्तांकों के आधार पर रैंकर्स की कक्षावार सूची तैयार की जाएगी। छात्रवृत्ति के लिए टॉप रैंकर्स का चयन किया जाएगा। छात्रवृत्तियों का विवरण इस प्रकार है -
